A herbicide use meeting will be held from 6-8pm Monday March 18th in the main conference room at the Owens building (Coos County Annex) in Coquille. All applicants are encouraged to attend. We will be able to help with your orders, identify weeds, treatment options and safety issues.

We have listed 2 options for surfactants. Herbimax is a heavier oil and better suited for woody stemmed vegetation. Those who prefer a lighter surfactant should order the LI 700.

If you have questions about the herbicides on our list or need information about controlling a particular weed, please call Steve Scheer: 541-404-4442. Leave a message and a number where you can be reached in the evenings.

Remember to include:

- Check or money order payable to Coos County (NO CASH)
- Plat map (8.5 x 11) with your property highlighted or draw a map that includes directions to your site.
- Herbicide Use Agreement must be signed and dated.
- Applications must arrive at the Coos County Board of Commissioner's Office no later than 5:00 pm on March 29th. Applications will not be accepted beyond this date.

2013 Herbicide Cost-Share Application Instructions
Please read before filling out application

Application Deadline: (Must arrive by) Friday, March 29th, 2013
(LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED)

- Please read entire application before filling out forms. Applications that do not comply with cost share rules will be returned with your check.
- Participants must reside on rural lands or own property within Coos County, out of city limits, or own one or more acres in urban boundary to be eligible for this program. Non resident landowners must provide a local contact for all cost share transactions.
- **Do not combine orders with friends or relatives. Each person ordering must provide a separate application. (It is illegal to purchase and “resell” herbicides)**
- Cost-share amount on herbicides and surfactant is 50%. A list of herbicides has been provided with cost-share amounts entered. Most herbicides must be used with a surfactant to achieve best results.

• **Order Limits – Orders are limited based on number of acres to be treated.**

5-50 acres = \$100

51-100 acres = \$200

101+ Acres = \$300

- **Please provide a plat map (or a sheet no larger than 8.5 x 11) with you property identified on the map and return it with you application.** If you don't have a plat map, draw a map of your location and area to be treated. Include your street address on the map.
- **Read and sign the Herbicide Use agreement and return it with your application.**
- **Payment may be made by check of money order payable to Coos County.** Send the payment along with your order. **(Do not Send Cash).** Mail or deliver to:

- **Be sure to include all of your contact information, including work and cell phone numbers. If you are unable to pick up your order at the designated times, you are responsible for making arrangements to have someone pick it up for you. For your protection, please share that information with us and provide contact information. No allowance will be made for herbicide pick up outside of posted times. Orders not picked up will be held over until the next cost share round.**
- **Herbicides should arrive by the within two (2) weeks of close of enrollment. You will be called with the day(s) and time(s) schedules for pick up as the Coos County Beaver Hill Disposal Site, (Usually Saturday morning). Remember, if you cannot make the day(s) and times(s) designated, it is your responsibility to find someone to pick up your herbicides in your place.**

- **Herbicides listed are for general public use. It is not required that you have a pesticide license to participate in this program.**

- All herbicides will be ordered through this program. Herbicides purchased independently, outside of this program will not be cost-shared.

Our herbicide use meeting will be on Monday March 18th 2013 from 6-8pm in the Coos County Annex (Owens Building) Coquille.

This meeting is informal and offers basic information such as:

- What herbicide to use for which weeds.
- Best times to use certain herbicides for best results.
- How to mix your spray batch.
- How to avoid herbicide drift.
- Using surfactants or fertilizer in your mix.
- Bring your unidentified weeds and we will help to identify them for you.
- Bring your questions and weed-killing success/failure stories.
- Assist in filling out your cost-share applications.

This meeting is not mandatory (but highly encouraged), but if you have not attended other herbicide use meetings in the past we ask that you attend so that you are aware of the laws governing herbicide use.

Herbicide Use Agreement

(Read, sign and return this agreement with your order. Make a copy for your files.)

I agree to follow the herbicide label directions, as it is the law for herbicide use. I agree to use the herbicides on my land or only with the written permission of the landowner of lands that I manage.

The use of some herbicides with surfactant can be a volatile mix and may cause herbicide to lift in a gaseous state and drift into unwanted areas if daytime temperatures reach over 70 degrees (first 24 hours). I have been informed that no greater than 4% of herbicide or surfactant should be used for the control of woody-stemmed vegetation and that using up to the maximum of 4% herbicide may also kill grass, trees or other vegetation.

I agree to take full responsibility for taking safety precautions when using this herbicide. I have been advised to wear eye safety protection, to wear protective clothing and to wash with cool water and soap when finished with herbicide application.

I agree to assume full responsibility for any employee, friend or family member in my charge if such employee, friend or family member is directed to use herbicides. I will advise them to read the label on mixing safety, protective clothing, eye protection and clean up.

I have been advised that all empty herbicide containers should be triple rinsed prior to disposal of the container. Triple-rinsed containers may be disposed at the county dump.

Herbicides have been provided by the Coos County Weed Advisory Board under a 50% Cost-Share Program from Federal Title II funding for the purpose of controlling roadside vegetation. In the event of unintended consequences, I agree to hold harmless Coos Bay District BLM, Coos County and all employees, agents, contractors, volunteers and affiliates of Coos County, regarding the use and storage of any herbicide or surfactant.

Pesticides are highly regulated under Oregon Law; and I have been advised that it is against the law for me to transfer any herbicide to another container for another's use.

I am the owner/manager of the property herbicides will be used on; I am over the age of 18 and I am authorized to sign for herbicide. I have read the Herbicide Use Agreement and understand that I am the responsible party in the use and application of herbicide. I agree to read and follow instructions per the label, to use safety precautions when using this herbicide; and to contact a professional consultant with questions regarding the use of herbicides.

I agree to apply the herbicides purchased from Coos County to the area described on my map on a regular schedule. If herbicides are not applied, I understand that Coos County may bill me for the County cost share of 50% of the herbicides that I have purchased.
